Habitat for Humanity ReStore Benefits

A Habitat ReStore is a retail operation that sells donated building materials and household items to the general public at **steeply discounted** prices.

Typically, these are brand new, overstocked, discontinued or slightly damaged goods donated by area businesses or very gently used items still in excellent condition donated by individual homeowners or contractors.

How Does The ReStore Operate?

The ReStore Inventory Team solicits donations and arranges pickups when necessary. Donated items and materials are priced to sell quickly to ensure inventory turnover. Not all items can be accepted for donation. There are guidelines as to what ReStore will accept based on age, quality and condition.

The Habitat ReStore has the right to refuse any donation for any reason

Provide a significant source of income to support the MHFH mission of building homes for the families in need.

Create jobs.

The ReStore is a green machine. It recycles materials that would usually go to the landfill.


Create opportunities to reduce home building costs by utilizing donated materials.



Acceptable Donations

Appliances in good working/physical condition (new or less than 6 yrs old)
Architectural Items (columns, posts, mantels, antique windows)

Cabinets with all doors/hardware and outer facings in good condition

Countertops in good condition with minimal chips or damage

Doors (exterior/interior entry) pre-hung or door slabs: 84" max., free of rot with all panes and hardware in tact

Sliding Glass Doors with all tracking, hardware and glass intact w/o broken seals or cracks

Electrical Supplies (wire, plugs, plates and associated hardware wiring).

Donations are required to be sorted/organized by type.

Ceiling Fans in operable condition with blades removed and taped to motor wall mounting hardware present

Non-Wood Flooring (area rugs in good physical condition, carpet & padding, vinyl and ceramic tile)

Solid Wood & Laminate Flooring free from surface damage and rot-minimum 25 SF

Furniture in excellent condition/contemporary in style (home and business)

Gutters & Leaders

Hardware for doors, cabinets, etc. in functional condition with all pieces present and assembled
Vents (floor, ceiling, return) clean and in good condition

Vinyl siding & Accessories (full length pieces only)
Lighting (fluorescent & incandescent) Complete fixtures with hardware and in operable condition.

Lumber (framing/trim/pressure treated plywood in full, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ sheets), milled lumber in 4 FT lengths or greater, siding in full lengths. All lumber is to be free of rot and insects.

Masonry (pavers and brick-whole, intact and in good condition)
Paint (new/full latex in 1 & 5 Gallon containers)


Plumbing Fixtures & Hardware Sinks (drop in style preferred). All surfaces are required to be in excellent condition and free from surface damage/stains.
Bathtubs (new or gently used accepted-must be in excellent physical condition). Claw foot accepted.

Plumbing Hardware Pipe (PVC/metal/copper)
Roofing Materials (shingles-full bundles only, minimum $\frac{1}{2}$ roll of roofing material)
Sheetrock (wallboard, drywall) 4' lengths & up with at least 4' salvageable
Tools (hand or power tools in operable condition)
Screens (clean and in good physical condition)

Windows (dual pane and complete sets only) all glass is required to be intact and in good physical condition. Wood windows required to be free from rot.

Window Treatments (drapes/blinds, shades)
Broken or Unframed Glass
Broken Mirrors
Mattresses/Box Springs
Clothing
Paint Thinner
Pesticides (liquid or powder)
Soft Goods
Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals
