PARKING PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Annual, semi-annual and monthly permits will be issued in the Clerk's Office. **ALL permits must be hung from the rearview mirror, facing out.** If there is no rearview mirror on the vehicle, the permit must be placed on the dashboard where it will be visible to the Enforcement Officer.

NOTE: A SUMMONS WILL BE ISSUED IF PARKING PERMITS ARE NOT LOCATED IN ACCEPTABLE LOCATIONS. THE FACT THAT A CURRENT PERMIT WAS ISSUED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS AN EXCUSE FOR ITS NOT BEING DISPLAYED PROPERLY. VEHICLES WITH PERMITS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN METERED SPACES UNLESS MONEY IS DEPOSITED IN THE METER. PERMITS ISSUED FOR THE FIRST AVENUE LOT MAY BE USED IN THE FIRST AVENUE LOT ONLY. ALL OTHER PERMITS WILL BE VALID IN THE BLOOMFIELD AVE., CHURCH ST., WEST MAIN AND MT. TABOR LOTS ONLY. PARKING IN SAVAGE ROAD LOT WILL BE FREE FOR COMMUTERS BUT OVERNIGHT PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED FOR COMMUTERS. COMMERCIAL PARKING WILL BE IN A DESIGNATED AREA IN THE SAVAGE ROAD LOT BY PERMIT ONLY. VEHICLES THAT PARK IN THE FIRST AVENUE LOT THAT DO NOT HAVE A FIRST AVENUE PERMIT WILL BE TICKETED.

PERMIT INFORMATION

1. Permits are required from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday in the First Avenue and West Main parking lots. Sunday parking is free. Bloomfield Avenue and Church Street lots are free on Saturday.
2. Permits must be displayed as instructed above on the first day that the permit is valid or a summons will be issued. **THERE WILL BE NO GRACE PERIOD.**
3. Vehicles should be locked at all times.
4. Denville Township is not responsible for lost permits. The Denville Township Clerk's Office must be notified if a permit is lost or stolen and an affidavit must be filed with that office. A replacement permit will be issued **at full price.**
5. Hanging permits are transferable from vehicle to vehicle.
6. If a permit is damaged, the old one must be brought to the Township Clerk's Office. The replacement fee is **\$5.00.**
7. **NO REFUNDS, REBATES OR PRO-RATED FEE FOR ANY PERMIT.**
8. Denville Township reserves the right to make any additions/deletions to these parking rules and regulations as deemed necessary and will notify permit holders of said changes in the event that they are implemented.
9. **ANY PERSON WHO ATTEMPTS TO REMOVE, TAMPER WITH OR HINDER PARKING ENFORCEMENT MATERIAL IS GUILTY OF A DISORDERLY PERSONS OFFENSE AND IS SUBJECT TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$2,000.**
