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DENVILLE RECREATION TEEN TRAVEL CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

PARENTS AND CAMPERS: PLEASE READ, SIGN, & RETURN TO DIRECTOR IMMEDIATELY.

Campers who attend the program are expected to follow the behavior guidelines and to interact appropriately in a group setting.

Behavior Guidelines

- Campers are responsible for their actions.
- We respect each other and the environment.
- Honesty will be the basis for all relationships and interactions.
- We will care for ourselves and those around us.

When a camper does not follow the behavior guidelines, we will take the following steps:

1. Staff will redirect the camper to more appropriate behavior. The camper will be reminded of the behavior guidelines and Summer Camp rules, and a discussion will take place with camper and counselor.
2. Camper will have to sit out of the activity with the director of the camp. Camper will have to explain to the director why they are choosing not to follow the rules and it will be up to the director when camper can rejoin the group.
3. If behavior continues a parent will be notified of inappropriate behavior via phone call.
4. The camper will need to be picked up from camp immediately by the parent or someone on their pick-up list.

If a camper's behavior at any time threatens the immediate safety of that camper, other camper, or staff, the parent may be notified and expected to pick up the camper immediately. If the problem persists and the camper continues to disrupt the summer program, the director reserves the right to suspend the camper from the program. Expulsion from the program will be considered in extreme situations. Refunds **will not** be given at any time in a case of suspension or expulsion.

The following behaviors are not acceptable and may result in the immediate suspension of a camper for the remainder of the current day and the next day:

- Endangering the health and safety of campers and/or staff, members, and volunteers
- Stealing or damaging summer camp or personal property
- Leaving the summer program without permission
- Continuing to disrupt the program
- Refusing to follow the behavior guidelines or summer program rules
- Using profanity, vulgarity, or obscenity frequently
- Acting in a lewd manner

If any of these behaviors continue, staff may suspend the camper a second time before expulsion. Immediate expulsion may occur if a camper is in possession of and/or using tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, firecrackers, firearms, or explosives.

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PROGRAM HOURS: 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. THERE WILL BE NO MORNING OR AFTERNOON CARE!!! Repeated late pick-ups may jeopardize your child's participation in the program. We will meet at the Valleyview Middle School gym for drop off and pick up. **Campers will have the option to sign themselves in and out of camp every day.**

YOUR CHILD WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING EACH DAY:

1. Lunch- there will not be a refrigerator or microwave available. On some trips, campers will have lunch at their own cost. Around \$10 is recommended to bring for lunch on those days. Also, some trips will have lunch included. Please refer to the trip schedule for the week to see if money is needed. 2. The Denville Recreation Summer Program does not provide sunscreen. You must provide sunscreen daily.

MEDICATION: Denville Recreation needs written parental authorization and instructions for any medication that needs to be administered. Any prescription or over-the-counter medication sent in must be in its original container and must be labeled with your child's name, the name of the drug, and directions for administering the drug. A new authorization form is needed each session. By law Denville recreation cannot administer any medication, prescription or over the counter, without written authorization. Denville Recreation cannot provide any medication.

DRESS CODE: When at the lake or at a water park, campers must wear appropriate swimsuits. IF YOUR CHILD WEARS INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING YOU WILL BE CONTACTED TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP. The staff has the discretion to determine what is appropriate and not appropriate. Appropriate shoes must be worn depending on the trip. If inappropriate shoes are worn it will be considered inappropriate clothing and will jeopardize the camper's participation for that day.

MISCELLANEOUS: 1. Please put your child's name on all items, and do not let your children bring cell phones, iPods, MP3 player, cameras etc. which could cause them grief if it were lost or damaged. 2. The Denville Recreation staff is not responsible for items that are brought to the program and are lost, damaged or stolen. 3. No staff members will hold onto camper's items on any trip. 4. Campers will be allowed to purchase souvenir at their own cost on trips that permit it.

ILLNESSES/ABSENCES: A sick child is to be kept at home for his/her own sake and for that of the other campers. If the child has had a fever or vomited within 24 hours he/she must stay at home. Denville Recreation should be informed about the nature of any illness. If your child has a communicable disease, such as chicken pox, ringworm, lice etc. he/she should be kept home. Denville Recreation will document the illness and will discretely post a notice to the other parents. The director will contact you during the day if your child becomes ill and you will have the option to come pick them up from our trip.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS: Refunds will not be given if you withdraw your child at any time from the program.

INJURIES: The Site Director and Staff will take whatever steps are necessary to administer emergency medical care if your child is injured. These steps may include, but are not limited to: 1. Attempt to contact the parent and/or guardian. 2. Attempt to contact you through any of the persons you listed on the Registration Form. 3. Call the Paramedics if necessary. 4. Have the child transported to the hospital accompanied by a staff member if necessary.

MISSED CHECK INS: Throughout the day campers will be required to check in with the staff at certain times and specific locations. If a camper misses the check in steps will be followed to ensure their safety such as: having them paged through the intercom, having them sit out the rest of the day, and having a chaperone with them at all times on all trips.
