Cancellation and Refund Policy:

Payments may be made by check or money order made payable to the Township of Denville.

Half of your payment must be paid on the day of registration.

The remaining balance of your payment is due no later than June 1st 2010.

Payments received after June 1st are subject to a \$50.00 late fee.

Last day for payments will be Friday June 11th.

No refunds will be given on partial payments.

Cancellations:

No refunds will be given after June 1st. Trips are non-refundable.

Discipline Policy:

At Denville Recreation's Summer Plus Program we seek to provide a safe and fun environment where children can enjoy themselves. The Summer Plus staff is very patient and tolerant. However, the camp does not tolerate behaviors that endanger the welfare of its campers or staff members. Any form of fighting will not be tolerated; this includes biting, kicking, scratching, punching, spitting, use of illegal drugs and alcohol, the carrying of dangerous weapons, ect. If a child exhibits any of these behaviors, Denville Recreation reserves the right to expel the child from camp without a refund.
